Purpose

Reason

CBC's previous pastor left on good terms in order to care for his aging father in another state. He left behind a grateful body of believers - a church accustomed to, and needful of, well-constructed and theologically substantive teaching. It is the desire of CBC's leadership that the church continue to offer teaching from which the Scriptures convince, convict, exhort, and encourage. CBC seeks a man whose love of the Lord and His word compels him to study the inspired text thoroughly, and meditate upon it continually - sharing both milk and meat from the pulpit as the Spirit leads.

Pastoral Duties

The pastor's duties include providing leadership and oversight to the ministry of our small congregation and to the surrounding community. Under our present schedule, the pastor will exposit the Scriptures twice each Sunday (one morning and one evening service). He will also teach, and lead a prayer meeting on Wednesday evenings.

The senior pastor would also be expected to carry out the following duties:

- Oversee, and, at times, present Sunday morning Bible study and Sunday School classes
- In cooperation with lay leadership, visit and minister to congregation members unable to attend regular church services (e.g., the homebound and hospitalized)
- Develop current and future leaders
- In cooperation with lay leadership, facilitate community outreach to the unchurched and misled in our area
