Ministry Duties:

- establish and facilitate the development of relationships with those under his ministry. This will include parental involvement as necessary.

- provide administrative oversight, planning, scheduling and coordination of the Youth and Young Adult ministries; and will communicate regularly with the Elder Board, Church Board, congregation, parents and staff the vision and progress of the ministry.
- manage the position of Youth and Young Adult Pastor to effectively reach the goals and objectives set forth by the Elders. In addition, to manage the position so that other staff, ministry departments, and the vision of MGBC is accomplished through teamwork in an efficient and effective manner.
- undertake those pastoral duties necessary to shepherd the body. These duties may include sermon presentation, teaching, weddings, funerals, and hospital visits.

- Have the gift of leadership and teaching (large groups and small) to be able to simplify Biblical principles in a practical way so as to provide life application.
- Be able to generate relational connection with students and adults within his ministry.
- Have an understanding of biblical discipleship and how to engage students and adults within his ministry.
