



DMin Interdisciplinary Studies Online and Hybrid DMin Concentrations

Grace Theological Seminary offers Doctor of Ministry (DMin) courses that include Online and Hybrid concentrations.

Online Concentrations: Online DMIN Concentrations require 8 seminars. The online program has no in person, on campus requirements. All course content is delivered asynchronously, though professors may offer limited live, real-time interactions.

Hybrid Concentrations: Hybrid DMIN Concentrations include a total of eight seminars taken in “hybrid” format, plus a final doctoral project. Four core seminars are taken online, and four concentration seminars are taken on campus. Each semester, Hybrid program students are encouraged to take two seminars: *an online seminar followed by an on campus seminar*. “On Campus” doctoral seminars have three course components: *pre-class, in-class, and post-class requirements*. (1) Three months prior to the first day of in-class attendance, course syllabi are made available for students to complete pre-class assignments. (2) Students then attend in-class campus seminars for 4 days (8am-5pm, Monday-Thursday). (3) Following in-class sessions, students have up to 3 months to complete post-class assignments.
