SUMMARY

The Student Pastor provides leadership and oversight for students in grades 7–12, including weekly programming, teaching, discipleship, and events. This role is responsible for casting vision, developing curriculum, and executing ministry strategies that help students grow in their faith. A key focus of this role is leading, equipping, and developing a team of adult and student volunteers to serve as small group leaders and ministry partners. The Student Pastor also collaborates with the Student Worship Associate to create meaningful worship experiences and maintain strong connections with students and families.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provides strategic leadership, vision, and direction for the Student Ministries team, ensuring alignment with the overall mission and vision of E91.
- Serves as the primary communicator/teacher for Student Ministries.
- Supervises the Student Ministries staff, interns, and volunteer team.
- Oversees and manages the Student Ministries budget.
- Oversees the Student Ministries volunteer team, including recruiting, equipping, and mobilizing volunteers to serve as small group leaders and ministry partners.
- Develops and implements strategies to engage students in serving opportunities in collaboration with Outreach staff team.
- Directs the vision and programming for middle school and high school worship gatherings, teaching, and community life with the NextGen Worship & Student Associate.
- Partners with the NextGen Worship Student Associate to create compelling and effective social media content and strategy.
- Attends weekly NextGen team meetings.
- Leads student ministry camps, retreats, and mission trips.
- Builds relationships and partnerships with para-church organizations to expand outreach to students in local schools and the broader community.
- Partners with parents and families to offer resources, care, and discipleship for spiritual growth.
- Performs weddings, funerals, and hospital visits as needed.
- Participates in the Sunday morning preaching rotation as part of the teaching team.
- Carries out additional responsibilities as assigned by church leadership.

MINIMUM REQUIRED EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, LICENSES AND/OR CERTIFICATIONS

This role requires a Bachelor's degree in a Ministerial Role and Ordination as a Pastor as well as three (3) to five (5) years progressively responsible professional level experience in a similar Christian Organization.
