The Pastor will work closely with the elders to develop and implement strategic plans that strengthen the church and extend its gospel impact in the surrounding community.

Pastoral Profile

We are seeking a man called to gospel ministry who demonstrates spiritual maturity, proven leadership, and a passion for shepherding God's people. The ideal candidate will:

- Have 5–10 years of pastoral ministry experience, preferably as an assistant or associate pastor in a medium-sized church
- Possess an entrepreneurial spirit with the ability to lead a smaller church toward healthy growth and greater community influence
- Be committed to preaching and teaching Scripture with clarity, conviction, and faithfulness
- Demonstrate a heart for discipleship, leadership development, and relational ministry

Core Competencies

The following characteristics are essential for effective ministry at FBC:

1. Biblical Communication

Effectively communicates God's Word through preaching, teaching, and equipping. Values expositional preaching and the authority of Scripture.

2. Leadership Development

Equips and mobilizes the congregation for ministry, while identifying and developing future leaders, particularly within the eldership.

3. Contextual Awareness

Understands and appreciates rural ministry in a “small church” context (50–200 attendees) and is able to build on existing strengths without unnecessary disruption.

4. Courageous and Creative Leadership

Willing to step out in faith, lead through change, and help the church move beyond its comfort zone to reach the community.

5. Vision and Execution

Able to cast clear vision, develop actionable plans, and follow through with consistency and accountability.

6. Community Engagement

Actively engages the local community and equips the church to build relationships and share the love of Christ in meaningful ways.

- **Elder-led with congregational involvement** – Our leadership structure reflects a shared commitment to biblical governance, clarified through a recent revision of our constitution

Candidating Process

1. Prayerfully consider this opportunity and seek the Lord's guidance
2. Submit a résumé, including:
 - Personal testimony
 - Ministry experience and strengths
 - Identified areas of personal and professional growth
 - 4–5 references
3. Provide links or recordings of 3–4 recent sermons (within the past 6–9 months)
4. Selected candidates will participate in an initial interview via Zoom with members of the search committee
5. Final candidates will be invited for:

- An on-site visit, including meetings with church leadership and congregation
- Opportunities to teach/preach in multiple settings
- A chance for the church to observe the candidate in a ministry context (as appropriate and respectful of current ministry commitments)
